Who do I report my concerns to?

Whistleblowing disclosures should be notified in the first instance to the DSL,
(unless this person is connected to the disclosure or for some other valid reason),
then it would be their line manager.

If it is a disclosure about the Headteacher it must be notified to the CEO.
